Eligibility:

To apply for an NSERC USRA, students must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada,
- Be registered (at the time of application) full-time in a bachelor's degree program in natural sciences or engineering,
- ➤ Have obtained, over the previous years of study, a CGPA of "B" (3.00/4.00); in accordance with NSERC, a B- may be accepted only under compelling circumstances,
- Have completed all course requirements of at least first year (two academic terms).
